Christ the King Partners with HBHH to help build a School in Cotelette, Haiti



Christ the King Catholic Church in Tampa, Florida has partnered with HBHH to help build the Cotelette School in St. Suzanne Parish in Fort Liberte Diocese. The new school will be called Christ the King School- Cotelette.

Construction is well on its way, thanks to your support and the generous support of Christ the King Catholic Church in Tampa, FL. The school should be finished in the spring of 2006. We have 90% of all the funds needed to complete construction.

In order to complete the school, we are currently working on obtaining used desks and the needed furnishings. We are also working on getting the funds for all the other furnishings, books, school supplies, and salaries for the teachers that will be needed to get the school operating in the fall of 2006.

Some of the Problems in Haiti:

Wells: Getting Water to the villagers in the mountains of St. Suzanne Parish continues to be a problem. Drilling a well in the mountains is not easy and is very costly. We are currently working on solutions so that we will be able to have 3 water sources in St. Suzanne: one at St. Suzanne Church in the village, one at St. Suzanne School, and one at Christ the King-Cotelette School.

Communication: With mail only delivered in the larger cities, little electricity, and almost no phone reception, communication as we know it does not exist. Priests in Fort Liberte diocese must physically get in a car and drive on horrible roads to see the Bishop in order to talk to him. We are investigating other avenues, trying to find an inexpensive solution to make communication easier.

Tampa Welcomes Bishop Chibly Langlois,

the Bishop of Fort Liberte Diocese in Haiti. Fort Liberte is in the Northeast corner of Haiti, one of the poorest areas in Haiti. It is very safe compared to the capital, Port-au-Prince, located in the southeast area of Haiti. The poverty and conditions are extreme in this area. So much is needed to bring Hope for the people in this area.
